RULES OF ENGAGEMENT FOR SEYMOUR OKTOBERFEST

- Please remember that this is a community event. Always be courteous and helpful to other participants. Several ministries, churches, and civic organizations view this as a significant fundraiser for their causes. We must be careful not to be a hindrance to those organizations.
- 2) Please ensure you are in groups of at least 2 or 3. But limit the size of your group so as not to look like a mob. We must not impede traffic or overwhelm folks.
- 3) The Broughton House will be open to all who are working with us on this outreach, but it is not a venue for bringing people you are ministering to or others who are not part of the group. If you feel you need to sit and minister with an individual for an extended period, please invite them to have coffee at Moxie Coffee or Larrison's Dinner, but do not bring that back to the house.
- 4) There will be a great variety of people at Oktoberfest. Remember to love them all.
- 5) Oktoberfest can be very crowded at times, and the space is small. You may find yourself separated from your group. Be sure you have the contact numbers of others in your group before you go.
- 6) We will see very few homeless people on this outreach, the festival committee and security personnel will police that closely.




